Purpose of Meeting

At this meeting, we had drone images of St. Raphael's estate. A presentation was given by Councillor Southwood and Councillor Tatler. One resident present gave a statement, following which Cabinet Members for Housing and Regeneration, ward councillors and a senior officer answered questions/spoke.

Across both public meetings, there were some clear themes. Families who are currently overcrowded were keen to know if new homes on the estate would be larger and, if so, what rent levels they would attract. People who are currently council tenants were keen to know if they would remain council tenants. People also asked about community facilities on the estate and whether comprehensive redevelopment would include improvements to these.
