Background

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a power which enables a charge to be levied on new development in order to fund infrastructure that is needed to support development.

In London CIL can be charged by both the Mayor of London and local authorities.

On 1 April 2012, the Mayor of London introduced a London-wide CIL which is used to collect contributions to assist with the funding of Crossrail, now known as the Elizabeth Line, and on 1 July 2013 Brent introduced a local CIL which is charged alongside the Mayor's CIL.

To ensure that the levy is open and transparent, Brent is required to prepare a short report on the levy to be published on our website by 31 December each year, for the previous financial year. This includes the details of Neighbourhood CIL.
