## What can I comment on?

At this stage the comments must relate to whether the proposals are in accordance with legal and procedural requirements (how we have prepared the Plan), and whether it is 'sound'. Soundness will be judged against the following criteria from the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF):

- Positively prepared providing a strategy which, as a minimum, seeks to meet the area's
  objectively assessed needs; and is informed by agreements with other authorities, so that
  unmet need from neighbouring areas is accommodated where it is practical to do so and is
  consistent with achieving sustainable development;
- **Justified** an appropriate strategy, taking into account the reasonable alternatives, and based on proportionate evidence;
- **Effective** deliverable over the plan period, and based on effective joint working on cross-boundary strategic matters that have been dealt with rather than deferred, as evidenced by the statement of common ground; and
- **Consistent with national policy** enabling the delivery of sustainable development in accordance with the policies in this Framework [the National Planning Policy Framework].
