Public Exhibition 01 - Event Summary

Brent Council and Karakusevic Carson Architects, supported by PPCR, held the first public exhibition over two days in July.

The purpose of the event was to re-cap on what has happened so far, give people a chance to meet the team (again) and talk about the upcoming journey towards a planning submission for Phase 1.

The events were held:

- Thursday 15 July 2021, 4-8pm
- Saturday 17 July 2021, 12-4pm

Alongside information boards and a model of the Phase 1 area there was an ice cream van serving free ice cream to residents, play equipment and free activity packs for children.

Summary

The event focused on giving people a re-cap on where we are at in the journey. The Project Team did not share much new information, but rather wanted to give a general update and introduction to the Phase 1 design process and programme.
