

ADOPTION STATEMENT – BRENT LOCAL PLAN 2019 - 2041

In accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Brent adopted Brent Local Plan 2019-2041 on 24th February 2022.

Brent Local Plan 2019-2041 was subject to an independent examination conducted by Inspectors Christa Masters MA (Hons) MRTPI and Andrew McCormack BSc (Hons) MRTPI, appointed by the Secretary of State. In their report published on 17th January 2022, the Inspectors confirmed the Plan, subject to a number of main modifications, to be sound, legally compliant and capable of adoption. The main modifications recommended by the Inspectors, together with additional minor modifications (which do not change the meaning of the policies) are included in the adopted Brent Local Plan. Any person aggrieved by the Brent Local Plan may, with the leave of the High Court, make an application under Section 113(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 to quash the Plan on the grounds that:

- Brent Local Plan is not within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Act; or
- a procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with.

Any such application for leave must be made to the Court no later than the end of the period of six weeks beginning with the day after the date on which the Brent Local Plan was adopted (i.e. beginning on 25th February 2022).
