

Notice of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Brent (“the council”) is conducting a review of its Parliamentary polling districts and polling places that fall within the Borough area.

1. The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the future Parliamentary constituencies of Wembley and Willesden will comment on the proposals. Those representations will be published on the Council’s website and will be available for inspection at the address below
2. Any changes to these constituencies polling districts and polling places will be implemented at the next general election and changes agreed by the council will also be introduced for the GLA polls taking place on Thursday 2 May 2024.
3. The council welcomes the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, or any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability, on any proposals in the ARO’s representations, or any other related matters.
4. Persons or bodies making representations of alternative polling places should, if possible, propose alternative locations within the appropriate polling districts.
